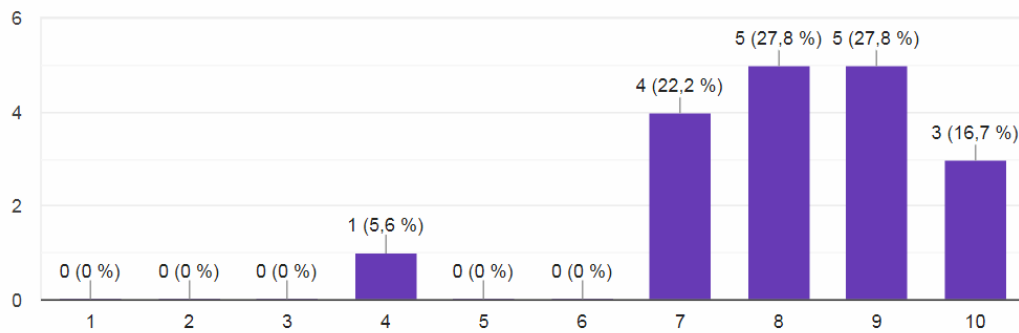

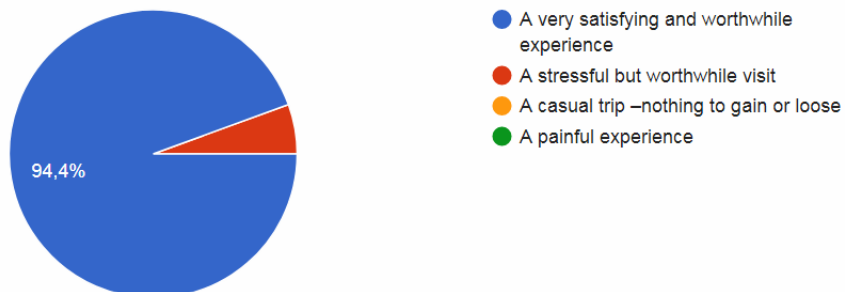

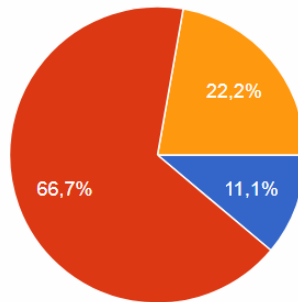

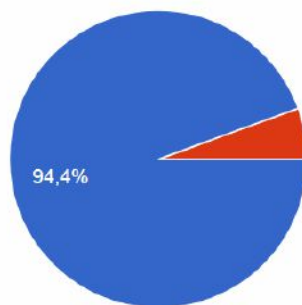

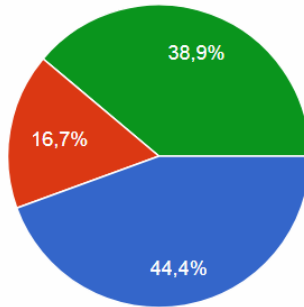

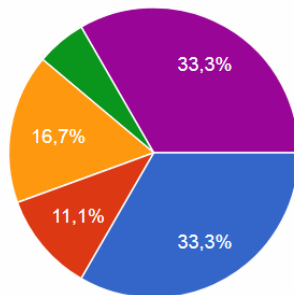

**Do you think your English has improved?**

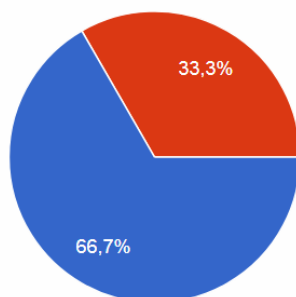

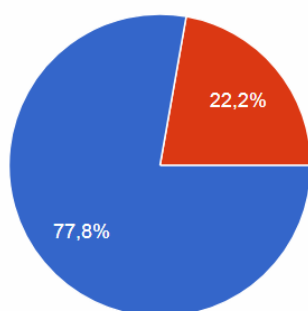

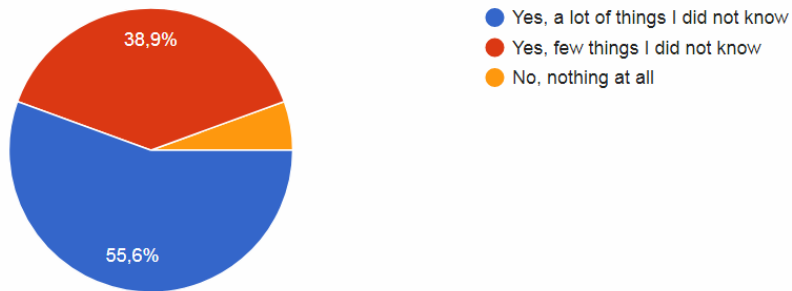

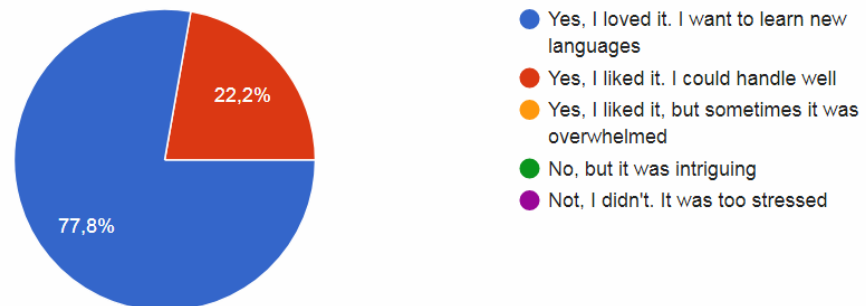
Have you learnt anything about the Polish culture (history, way of living, gastronomy...) in both book and film “The witcher” and during the trip to Gorzow Wielkopolski?

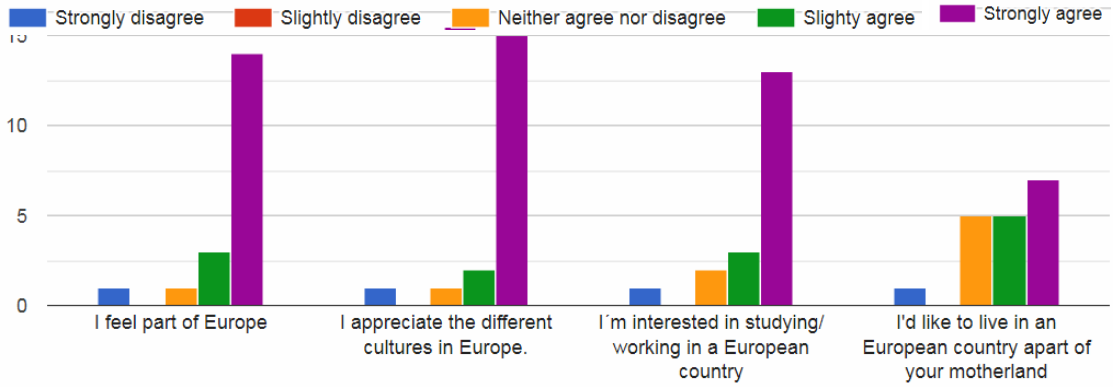

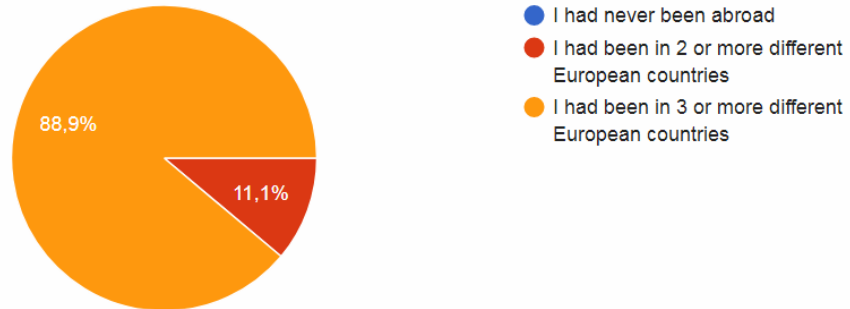


### What do you think about Europe?
